The All German Car Show is a unique opportunity for car enthusiasts and the general public to explore a diverse lineup of vehicles, connect with club members, and enjoy a morning filled with automotive passion. Whether you're a fan of timeless classics or high-performance sports cars, this event promises something for everyone.

This year’s show will include a special highlight—the handoff of the 2025 Art Car to students from Shawnee Mission East High School at approximately 10:00 AM. The car, a Porsche, will be turned over to the student team for their upcoming artistic transformation project. Sponsored by the Kansas City Automotive Museum, the Art Car program is an educational initiative that combines creative design, technical skills, and real-world experience for local high school students. The completed Art Car will make its debut at the 2025 Mecum Auction, with proceeds benefiting the Museum.
