

K-12 FIELD TRIP OPPORTUNITIES

The Kansas City Automotive Museum offers tours specialized for students of all ages. Tours may be requested specifically for elementary school, middle school, or high school students.

HISTORICAL TOURS

- Students will be guided through Kansas City Automotive Museum by one or more of the museum's highly knowledgeable docents. Along the way, students will learn about the history of the automobile industry in Kansas City.
- In the Homer B. Roberts and Greenlease Galleries, topics include Kansas City's early car manufacturers, progress in engineering, the city's first car dealerships and city-wide infrastructure.
- The Drive-In Gallery features a display of vehicles which change each month. Monthly themes for the remainder of 2024 are as follows:

September: Mercedes-Benz October: Packards November: Camaros

December: Cords (American luxury automobiles manufactured from 1929 to 1937)

We will have a fabulous lineup in 2025 as well but those announcements have not yet been made.

- The C.A.R.B. Hall of Fame, Grand Hall and Wagoner Galleries are home to a unique collection of vehicles ranging from race cars to variety of British, American, German and other car models from all eras.
- Field trips take about an hour. KCAM is able to accommodate up to 50 students for each tour; however, larger groups will be divided into groups 15 or fewer students. Tours may be scheduled Tuesdays through Fridays between the hours of 10:30 am and 3:30 pm.
- Cost is \$5 per per person (students and adults) and must be paid in advance.
